No late admittance

Cost – Registration Fee per day for 2 courses is \$30 for MCBR members and \$50 for non-members and includes all course materials, exam and lunch.
Continuing Education – With the start of the 2009-2010 biennium, all licensees must complete six Department of Regulation and Licensing (DRL)-approved courses for a total of 18 hours before December 14, 2010. There are four mandatory courses and a list of DRL-approved electives. Licensees must complete the four mandatory courses and two electives from the DRL-approved electives list. The WRA’s continuing Education courses are approved courses and satisfy this requirement.
New Licensees – A “new” licensee is anyone who was granted an original broker’s or salesperson’s license during 2008-2009 and who was not licensed to practice as either a broker or salesperson on the first day of the biennium, is not required to satisfy the continuing education requirement during the 2009-2010 licensing period.
